Elders' Comments

What did the elders have in mind in the new Sunday assembly schedule? Other than Sunday being the Lord's day when His people come together for worship, feeding the church and convenience were in mind. The two sermons and Bible classes provide the food, and those who want it will be present for it. Much thought and study go into our spiritual food preparation, and those who preach and teach it do so in a powerful and convincing way. No one goes away feeling spiritually hungry. Convenience for the most people was another consideration. Rather than returning at 5 or 6 PM. or even earlier at 1:00 or 1:30, we believe more members would rather follow the schedule we have planned and go home for the rest of the day. We encourage everyone to give it your best. Put the Lord first on the Lord's day. Be a part of both worship services and your Bible class. Attending Wednesday night classes is also a plus for the growing Christian. We urge you to consider it's importance. You will be blessed in doing so.

PASTORS THAT FEED THE FLOCK

How many meals and snacks do you normally eat in a day, in a week in a year? Could you live on just one meal per week with no snack? If that were all the nourishment you received it would not be long till you would be weak, and sickly. Physical nourishment is essential for a healthy life. Occasional fasting may be helpful, but we know we must have regular nutrition because without it our body will die.

As children of God, we need spiritual nourishment to grow individually and collectively as a body of Christians. God in pleading for His backsliding children to repent and return to Him promised, "And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding" (Jeremiah 3:15). In the New Testament the apostle Paul in his instructions to the elders of the church at Ephesus told them to, "feed the church of God" (Acts 20:28). Elders, the pastors of the local congregation, are responsible to adequately feed the flock.

In addition, Christians need more time together to learn, grow and encourage one another. Following the establishment of the church the new Christians were together daily (Acts 2:46). The Bereans searched the scriptures daily to see if the apostle Paul was teaching truth (Acts 17:11). In a world that is constantly pulling us away from God and His word we need time together to counteract that negative influence.

The Hebrew writer admonishes Christians, "Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God; whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation" (Hebrews 13:7). In the same chapter we find, "Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you" (13:17). As elders we have the responsibility to feed and watch for the souls of all the members. A shepherd would not have a flock for long if he only spent two to three hours per week with them. The new schedule for Bible classes and worship assemblies is an effort on the part of the elders to fulfill our responsibility to the members. We ask all the members to put forth every effort to attend all of the services of the church.
