## GREET ONE ANOTHER

The Lord's Church is not only a place where God's truth is taught and practiced, but also a place of love and care and attention. In Rom. 12:10, the Lord's Church is told "Love one another with brotherly affection." In Rom. 16: 1-16, Paul mentioned 27 people by name; 17 were personal references, and 19 were references of commending and greeting one another. Paul never missed an opportunity to build somebody up. When our vertical relationship with God is right, it is amazing how deep our horizontal relationships become.

### Paul gives us three necessities for the Lord's church:

**WE MUST MAKE ROOM FOR ALL KINDS OF PEOPLE:** Paul's list contains men and women; young and old; single and married; wealthy and poor. What kept them close? It was their oneness in Jesus. Ten times in sixteen verses Paul talks about them being "in Christ," or "in the Lord." In the body of Christ, we have the perfect environment for brotherly love. We have the freedom to be ourselves and yet share the common bond in our commitment to Jesus.

**WE MUST EXPRESS OUR APPRECIATION FOR EACH OTHER: PAUL SAYS,** "Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor" (Rom.12:10). There are several people that Paul's letter shows honor to because that is how we produce "brotherly affection."

**WE MUST NEVER TAKE "ONE ANOTHER" FOR GRANTED:** It would be hard to imagine Paul coming to worship on Sunday, walking in without talking to anyone; sitting through worship and getting up and seeing how quick he could leave. The more we live in a fallen world, the more refreshing it is to worship and fellowship with other Christians.
