## MEMBERS OF ONE ANOTHER

The most common “one another” command in the Bible is “Love one another.” The best way we can love one another is to practice the “one another” commands found in the God’s word.

To Christians in Rome, Paul wrote: “so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another” (Rom. 12:5). In 1Cor:12:12-27, Paul gives three areas Christians should emphasize to help them be “members of one another.”

- 1) **WE MUST EMPHASIZE OUR DEPENDENCY** (12:18-21): A Christian is like a hand. No matter how useful that hand may be, apart from the body it will never be useful to the body. Paul teaches us that we cannot spiritually survive without the body, and the body is not made in such a way that it will tolerate independence from its members. Being “members one of another” is much more than being on a church role, we must be independent on each other.
- 2) **WE MUST EMPHASIZE OUR EQUALITY** (12:22-24): No Christian should feel more or less important than any other Christian. God has deliberately made up our bodies so that the less seen parts are vital. In the Lord’s church there are lots of people working behind the scenes so that others can serve visibly, but everyone is needed and appreciated. Being “members one of another” is not just being on a role, it is working together.
- 3) **WE MUST EMPHASIZE OUR UNITY** (12:12): Paul is very clear that the Body is a unit. God designed our physical bodies to love harmony and hate discord. In the Lord’s Body all members must be going in the right direction or there will be problems. There is nothing that will destroy the purpose of the Lord’s church faster than division in the Body. Paul says there should be “no divisions in the body” (12:25), that’s why we should be “eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace” (Eph. 4:3)
