THE POWER OF GOOD WORKS

Jesus said it best! *"Let your light shine before men that they may see your good works and glorify your Father who is in heaven."* (Matt.5:16) When we are faithful in assembling with the church, our neighbors are aware of it, but it does not really impress them. Many people do that. "They are church going people" may be a passing comment about us. However, when we are engaged in good works, it makes quite a different impression on the people we are helping and on anyone who happens to see it.

A young Christian woman with two small children was scheduled for some serious surgery. Her husband had taken a job several hundred miles away from either of their families, so relatives were not close to help out. Christian friends kept the children while she was hospitalized. A few friends from the church cleaned her house and mowed the lawn the day before the couple came home. A different person brought a hot meal each day while she was recovering. A neighbor watched this with interest. A few days later the neighbor met the young woman at the mailbox and visited a few minutes. During their conversation, the neighbor asked about all the people who had helped. "Oh, those are my friends in our church family. I don't know what we would have done without them," was her reply. The neighbor then said, "I would like to know more about your church." It was not long until this neighbor was baptized into Christ.

It was the good works done by the church that first attracted this neighbor to the Lord. They simply followed the directions Jesus gave in letting their light shine before men. Before seeing the good works, had someone from the church knocked on her door and invited her, likely she would not have been interested. But when she saw the good works, she wanted to know more. This is why there is so much emphasis in scripture about doing good works. *"For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."* (Eph.2:10) We are commanded to *"be fruitful in every good work."* (Col.1:10) We are to be *"always abounding in the work of the Lord."* (1 Cor.15:58) Good works are a natural outpouring of faith and love for God. And when we submit to God's will in this matter, He provides the tools and means for good works. *"And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work."* (II Cor. 9:8) He provides for us, and He blesses us when we are engaged in helping others.

Someone has put it in these words: "There is no impression, unless there is a corresponding expression." The Good News of the Gospel impressed us because of the expression of God's love to man. If that impression is to continue, Christ and Christianity must be expressed in our living.
