# A PLEA FOR SPIRITUAL MATURITY.

The book of Hebrews was written to encourage wavering, immature, Jewish Christians to endure persecution and remain faithful to Christ. Because they were tempted to fall back into Judaism, the author repeatedly exhorts them by showing the superiority of Christ over all that the Jewish economy had provided for them. He did this by encouraging and warning. They were not growing in Christ as they should be, and their souls were in danger of being lost.

1. They were to be cautious about drifting away from what they had heard. (2:1)
2. They were in danger of neglecting their salvation. (2:3)
3. They were exhorted not to harden their hearts. (3:7,8)
4. They were to beware lest any of them depart from the living God. (3:12)
5. They were to exhort one another not to be hardened by sin. (3:13)
6. They were to hold the beginning of their confidence to the end. (3:14)
7. They were to fear lest any of them come short of their rest. (heaven) (4:1ff)
8. They were to be diligent to enter their rest. (4:11)
9. They were to hold fast their confession. (4:14)
10. They were to find help in time of need from the throne of grace. (4:16)
11. They were becoming dull of hearing. (5:11)
12. They were feeding on milk, rather than solid food. (5:12-14)
13. They were exhorted to leave first principles and go on to perfection. (6:1ff)
14. They were in danger of falling away forever. (6:4-6)
15. They were exhorted to show the same diligence they had in the past. (6:9ff)
16. They were to hold fast the confidence of their hope without wavering.(10:23)
17. They were to stir up love and good works in one another. (10:24)
18. They were not to forsake the assemblies of the church. (10:25)
19. They were not to be guilty of willful sin. (10:26ff)
20. They were not to lose confidence and draw back. (10:35-39)
21. They were to lay aside every weight and sin in their race. (12:1, 2)
22. They were to strengthen themselves, lest anyone fall short. (12:12-15)
23. They were to let brotherly love continue. (13:1)
24. They were to let their conduct be without covetousness. (13:5)
25. They were to obey those who ruled over them and be submissive. (13:7, 17)
