KNOW, THEN APPLY

Ok, I will confess, I'm a book-a-holic. I read several books each month, mostly books in the field of Christianity but I do have a few non-religious books in my library. For example, I have my DIET COOKBOOKS.

My diet cookbooks are all about healthy eating. I have vegan diet books, cookbooks for diabetics since that issue is in my family history, low sodium diet cookbooks, and diet cookbooks about using foods to lower blood pressure, another health problem in my bloodline. Still, with all the many diet books I have, I am currently 34 pounds over the optimal weight my physician would prefer. Why am I overweight? It's all a matter of application. I know what I should be eating but I fail to apply that knowledge.

As a Christian, it's not really an issue of knowing that I need to be a better student of God's Word; it's a matter of studying God's Word and applying that knowledge.

The Psalmist wrote, "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." (Ps.119:105) A flashlight tucked away in a drawer is useless when the power goes out, unless it is turned on and used. The Bible becomes useless if it remains on the bookshelf, gathering dust like my diet cookbooks.

The Bible needs to be applied to the life of the Christian. Paul reminded Timothy, "All scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work." (II Tim. 3:16-17)

The Bible does a superb job at teaching, reproof, correcting, and training in righteousness but ONLY if it is applied. Like the medication in the bottle, the Bible works only if it is brought out and used.
