FAITH OR DOUBT

We live in an age of doubt. Doubt reigns worldwide. People doubt the existence of God, the inspiration of the Bible, the reality of heaven and hell, and man's accountability to God. When the problems we face should be drawing us nearer to God and increasing our need for faith, it is doubt that is growing in practically every age group of society, and often even in the church.

It is important for Christians to know what we believe and why we believe it. Faith is not mere opinion or speculation. It is not a guess or a blind leap in the dark. Faith is conviction based on evidence. (Heb.11:1) Since it is impossible to please God without faith (Heb.11:6), it is imperative that we strengthen and build our faith in God, Christ and the Bible. We must be ready always to give a reason for the hope within us, with meekness and fear. (I Pet.3:15) If we have hope, we should know the reason for it and be ready to give answer to others.

Many people express opinions, but few have convictions based on biblical teaching. The word of God is food for the soul. Jesus said that "man must live by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God". (Matt.4:4) This was a quotation of the inspired words of Moses some fifteen hundred years earlier, which were still true, and will always be true. Why? Because it is the word of God that builds faith. (Rom.10:17) Without it there is no faith. We feed our faith by studying the word of God. We feed our doubt by studying the opinions of men. It's a matter of choice as to whether we increase our faith or our doubt. And we choose which it will be - faith or doubt - each and every day that we live.
